By Laws contained in this document are written in accordance with the provisions set out in Liverpool City Archers Constitution Effectivity Date: 24th July 2022 FY22 AGM

In accordance with:

Clause 5. Membership

b. (1) The Applicant makes application for membership as set out in the Archery Australia Rules or Club By-laws

Clause 12. INFRINGEMENT OF RULES OF CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAW

a. Each member will comply with the provisions of the constitution, rules and by-laws of Archery Australia, ANSW and the Club.

Clause 30. BY-LAWS

1. The Committee is empowered to make by-laws that are not inconsistent with the constitution. The Committee may repeal and amend such by-laws as they may from time to time consider necessary for the wellbeing of the Club, which by-laws, repeals and amendments will have effect until otherwise determined by the Committee or General Meeting.

By Law 2024.1

Reference to Clauses 5.b.1, 5.b.4. 12.a,b,c,d,e

The Club Rules and Regulations Booklet is to be considered an extension of the operational rules of Liverpool City Archers Inc, and therefore, members must agree to the Clubs Rules and Regulations when joining as members.

By Law 2024.2

Reference to Clauses 20. a,b 25.1,2,3

Eligibility for Appendix 2 includes the following criteria:

- (a) Be a full financial member of the club for greater than a 12 Month period.
- (b) Be an active participant of the club events for no less than a 6-month period.

Exclusions from Appendix 2 includes the following criteria:

- (a) Having a membership terminated or a membership rejected from any other Archery club in Australia.
- (b) Have been previously removed from the committee in accordance with clause 29 of the constitution.

By Law 2024.3

Ref: Clause 28.5

- (i) If an objection is received from the floor during the election process as per Appendix 2, a 5 (five) minute adjournment will be called and minuted, unless the nominated person withdraws their nomination
- (ii) Only 1 (one) objector will be permitted to present their reasons for the objection.
- (iii) The objector and nominated person are permitted 2 (two) minutes each to present their reasons for and against.
- (iv) The objector will present first, followed by the nominated person.
- (v) After this time a secret ballot will be held as per clause 28.2 with the majority vote carried.

By Law 2024.4

Life membership fees will be paid for in full by the club for all active life members.
